Why should I have my child screened?

The purpose of the 60 minute screening is to detect possible developmental delays that might negatively affect a child's learning.

Will a preschool screening tell me if my child is ready for Kindergarten?

Children will be screened in the areas of speech, language, hearing, vision, motor skills, play skills and cognitive skills to detect possible developmental delays. This screening will NOT determine whether a child is ready for kindergarten.

Who will do the screening?

The preschool diagnostic team will complete the screening. The Diagnostic team includes: A Special Education Teacher, Speech and Language Pathologist, School Psychologist, School Social Worker, and School Nurse. Physical and Occupational Therapists are included as needed.

When will I get the results?

A member of the diagnostic team will make every attempt to convey results within 2 weeks of the screening. You will be contacted by mail and depending on the results you may receive a phone call from a member of the diagnostic team.
